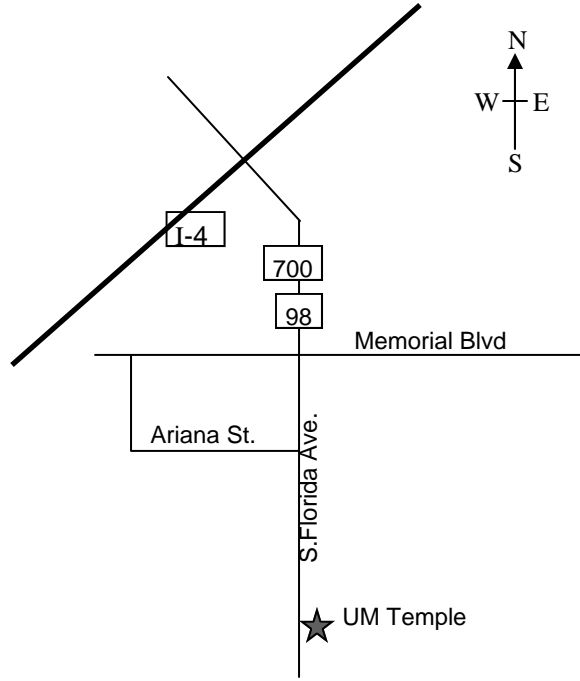

**Florida Storm Recovery** repairing Homes with RPAD, Rebuild Polk After Disaster, working to repair under and uninsured homes in the areas around Lakeland affected by the hurricanes of 2004.



**Celebrate Jesus** will engage in relational evangelization on June 1<sup>st</sup> in the downtown area of Lakeland surrounding Wesley United Methodist Church. The community will be invited to a Celebrate Jesus Block Party that will take place on Sunday, June 5, in the neighborhood.



**Habitat for Humanity** builds homes with future homeowners providing “sweat equity” while volunteers work alongside them. You can “sling a hammer” or saw lumber, and support a family to own their home. The home site will be assigned at registration.



**The Society of St. Andrew and the Reverse Potato Drop.** Purchase a five pound bag of potatoes from your local grocery store, or from a Lakeland grocery store when you arrive. Signs will direct you to “drop” your bag of potatoes in a marked bin at the Lakeland Center. The Society of St. Andrew will distribute all the potatoes to food distribution charities who feed hungry people in the community. You need not pre-register for this event. Registration is automatic when you bring a bag of potatoes. This event happens on June 2 - 3.
