ETHICAL DECISION-MAKING QUESTIONS

1. What are the ethical issues at stake in this situation?
2. What are the pertinent legal, ethical, moral, or Disciplinary requirements?
3. What roles and responsibilities do I have? What roles and responsibilities do others have? Is there anyone else who should be consulted?
4. What steps should be taken?

HOW TO REPORT

1. Document all incidents and all actions taken.
2. Report to District Superintendent. If DS is involved, report to Bishop.
3. If appropriate, file written complaint.
4. If minors, elderly, or vulnerable adults involved, IMMEDIATELY report to DCF and law enforcement. Document all actions taken. **CALL: 1-800-96 ABUSE or 1-800-962-2873**
5. Document any retaliation.
6. Seek support.
