Between the 3rd and the 30th of January of the current year the Annual Methodist Conference of the East of Angola made the basic formation course in Theology. The course aims to offer elementary theological preparation for lay leaders and future pastors who have been called by God to serve in the pastoral ministry. In this course I taught the subjects of Methodism and Homiletics.

The Imagine No Malaria program in the East of Angola continues to show significant progress.

The first stage of home visits and health education ended in January of this year. The first phase allowed to census in the

Quéssua area a population universe of approximately 4500 people. Volunteer facilitators offer health instruction to the population through educational talks.
