**SB 60/HB 217 'KEYS TO INDEPENDENCE'.** Support for teens living in out-of-home care to secure driver licenses.

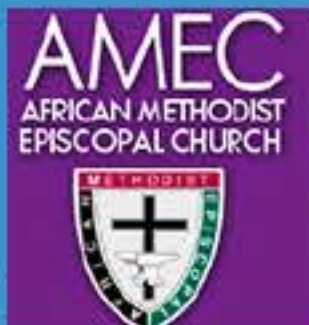
**SB 852 HUMAN TRAFFICKING.** Required and more comprehensive support for child victims of human trafficking.
